## Summary

Maidenhair Fern

Adiantum capillus-veneris

Maidenhair Fern is one of our rarest ferns which occurs infrequently in the UK. In NW England it only grows in a few places round Morecambe Bay. It likes calcareous cliffs where its roots are protected. It can be found in grykes on Limestone Pavement in places like the Burren. It was found growing naturally by the Coastguard Station and in the Quarry at Arnside, (sites 1 and 2). With agreement from the land owner some seedlings were removed and grown on in 2018. 2 plants were planted out in Ashmeadow and the rest were grown on to produce spores and also for use by the BOOM project. They planted 3 colony sites here (Woodwell and 2 at Storth Cutting). Adiantum is frost hardy and some fronds stay green all winter. However it can not tolerate drought and prefers tufa rock where the water drips down the rock face. After unsuccessful attempts with plug plants at Woodwell in 2018, spores were blown onto the tufa in 2019 and 2021 and by 2023 new seedlings were growing. Additional plug plants were added by BOOM in 2023. These are doing well.
