Habitat: Water Bodies: Alisma plantago-aquatica can be confused with Baldellia ranunculoides.



However it has much wider leaves, smaller flowers and is much taller.

The Common Water-plantain seedpods, shown on the right top, look triangular. Those of Baldellia, right below, look like buttercup seeds

It may be fairly common at Leighton Moss but is easily hidden by the reeds. It may also occur at places like Silverdale Moss and Barrow Scout.
