
This is a small sedge that flowers very early in the year. It is a plant of limestone grassland. It is one of the first sedges to flower. The best time is the 2nd week in April to the 2nd week in May. The male spike is just above the **unstalked** female spikes. It is easy to confuse it with Spring sedge Carex caryophyllea. However you can tell them apart with a hand lens. Carex ericetorum has dark brown/purplish glumes with a light edge and a rounded tip.



Carex caryophyllea has light brown/green glumes with a pointed tip.
