

Red Bartsia is a small annual plant of roadside and footpath edges. It is hemi-parasitic on various grasses. Leaves vary from almost red to green. These are a few of the sites reported.

4774	Leighton Moss	SD4770274662	AK	22/07/2023	several	on LHS just before bridge going to Tim Jackson Hide
4776	Challan Hall	SD4760876707	AK	24/07/2023	several	patch on LHS going down from road just before cottage
4777	RSPB Challon woods	SD4761577282	AK	12/08/2023	lots	All the way from the road to the bridge at Silverdale Moss with large patches in each field.
4778	Dollywood Lane	SD4771078533	AK	05/07/2023	a single plant	in grass at edge of track just before gate
4875	Leighton Moss Causeway	SD4809375159	AK	10/08/2024	lots	All the way down the causeway on both sides of the path

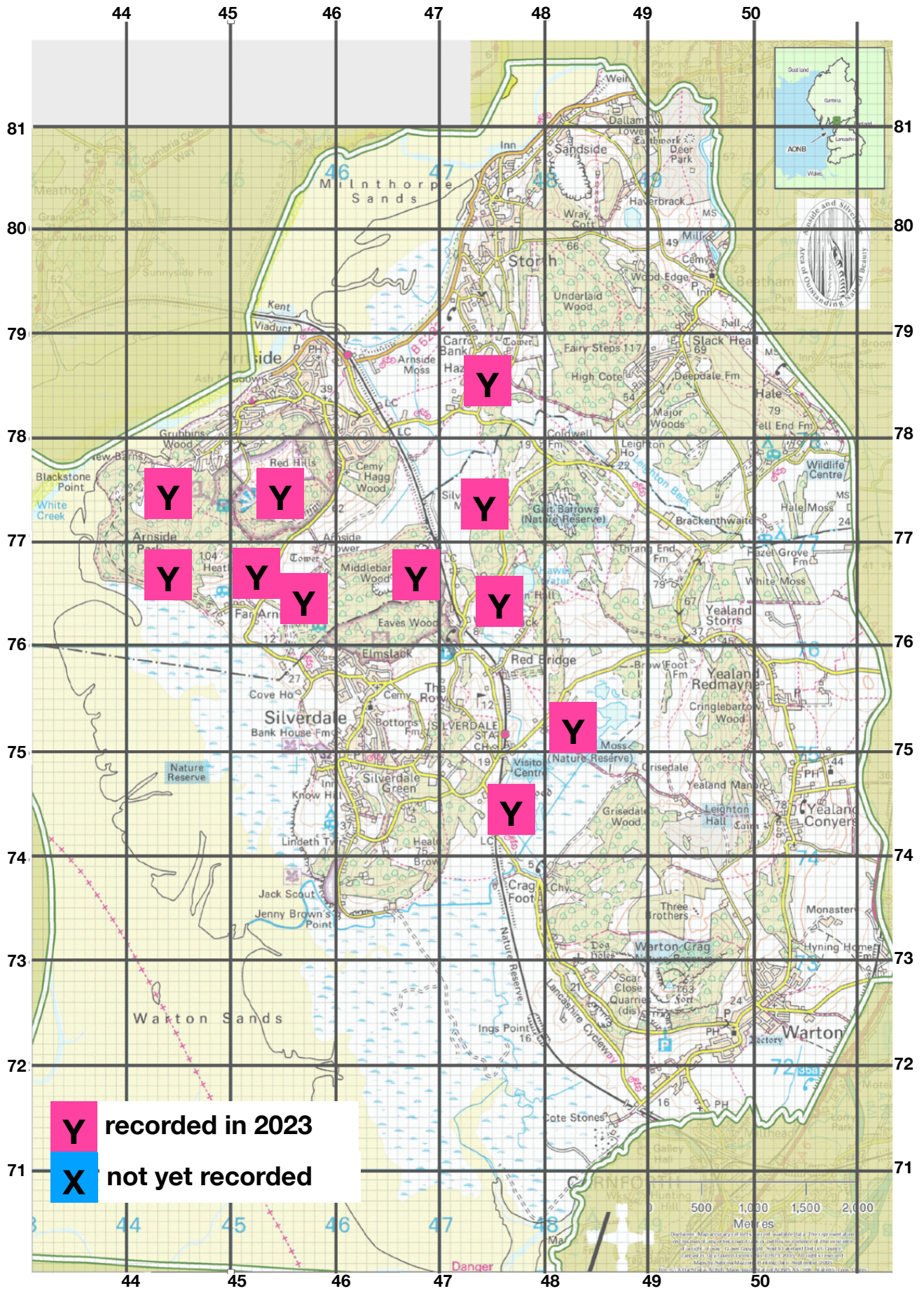
