This is a biennual/annual that likes to grow in the shade by limestone rocks. Very variable in height and can reach 60cm, depending on the weather. It has white four petalled flowers but these are small and can be missing their petals. Flowers May to July. The rosette is shown in A. Don't confuse it with Cardamine hirsuta (B) which has much more rounded leaves.





The pods are long and cylindrical. Note that one distinctive feature is that the base of the leaves clasp the stems. Sometimes the white petals are missing.
